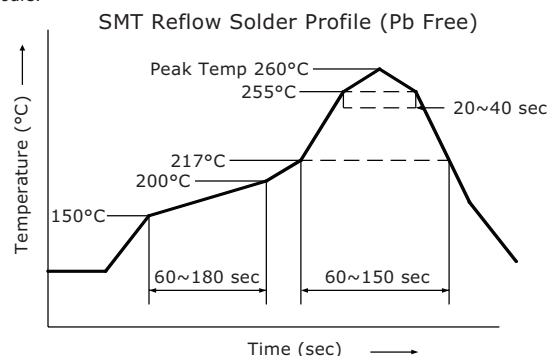

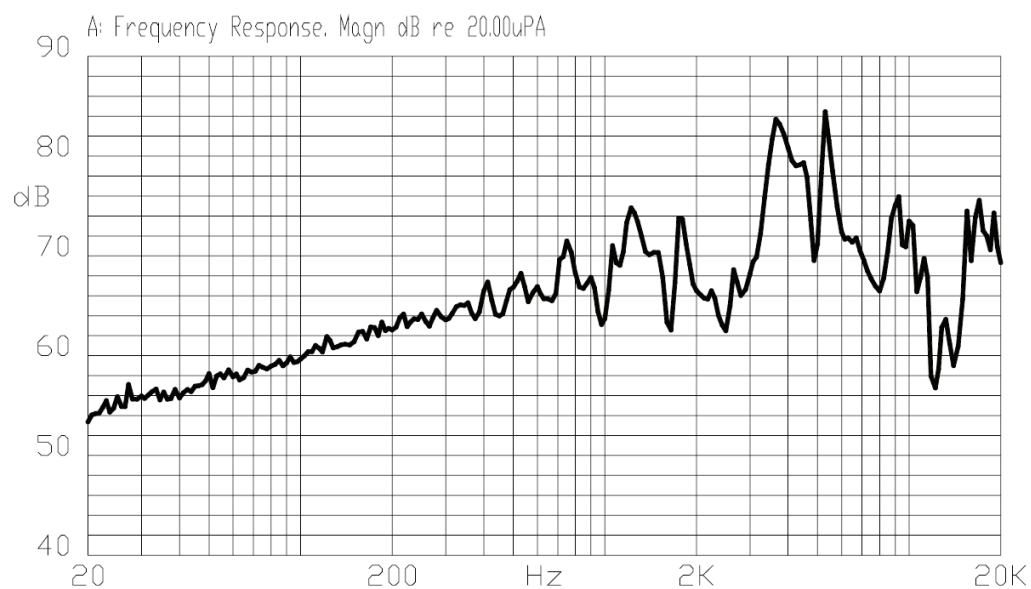

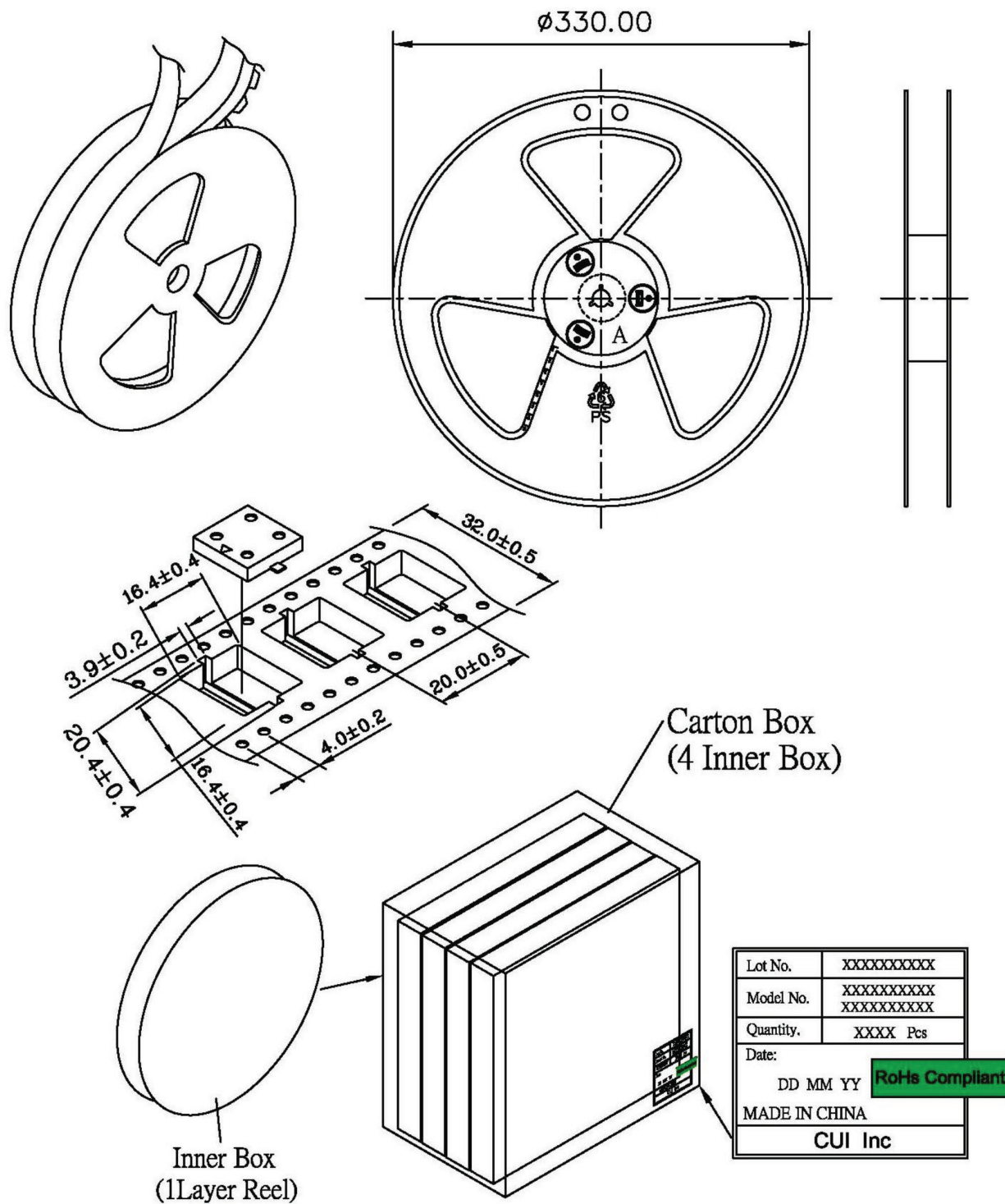
FREQUENCY RESPONSE CURVE
