Product data sheet

General description 1.

The 74AUP1G58 provides configurable multiple functions. The output state is determined by eight patterns of 3-bit input. The user can choose the logic functions AND, OR, NAND, NOR, XOR, inverter and buffer. All inputs can be connected to $\ensuremath{\text{V}_{\text{CC}}}$ or GND.

This device ensures a very low static and dynamic power consumption across the entire V_{CC} range from 0.8 V to 3.6 V.

This device is fully specified for partial power-down applications using I_{OFF}.

The I_{OFF} circuitry disables the output, preventing the damaging backflow current through the device when it is powered down.

The 74AUP1G58 has Schmitt trigger inputs making it capable of transforming slowly changing input signals into sharply defined, jitter-free output signals.

The inputs switch at different points for positive and negative-going signals. The difference between the positive voltage V_{T+} and the negative voltage V_{T-} is defined as the input hysteresis voltage V_H.








Fig 6. 2-input NAND gate or 2-input OR with both inputs inverted




Fig 7. 2-input AND gate with inverted B input or 2-input NOR gate with inverted C input

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


Fig 8. 2-input AND gate with inverted C input or 2-input NOR gate with inverted A input






Fig 9. 2-input OR gate or 2-input NAND gate with both inputs inverted







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


Fig 17. Typical transfer characteristics; $V_{CC} = 1.8 \text{ V}$




Fig 18. Typical transfer characteristics; $V_{CC} = 3.0 \text{ V}$

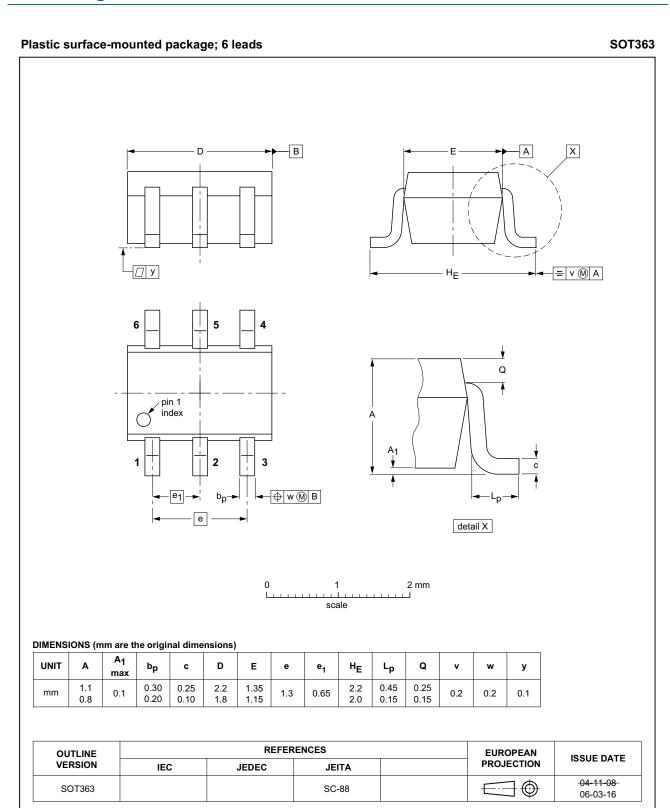


Fig 19. Package outline SOT363 (SC-88)

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


Fig 20. Package outline SOT886 (XSON6)

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


Fig 21. Package outline SOT891 (XSON6)

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


Fig 22. Package outline SOT1115 (XSON6)

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


Fig 23. Package outline SOT1202 (XSON6)




Fig 24. Package outline SOT1255 (X2SON6)
