74ABT646 Octal Transceivers and Registers with 3-STATE Outputs

General Description

The ABT646 consists of bus transceiver circuits with 3-STATE, D-type flip-flops, and control circuitry arranged for multiplexed transmission of data directly from the input bus or from the internal registers. Data on the A or B bus will be clocked into the registers as the appropriate clock pin goes to a high logic level. Control $\overline{\text{OE}}$ and direction pins are provided to control the transceiver function. In the transceiver mode, data present at the high impedance port may be stored in either the A or the B register or in both. The select controls can multiplex stored and real-time (transparent mode) data. The direction control determines which bus will receive data when the enable control $\overline{\text{OE}}$ is Active LOW. In the isolation mode (control $\overline{\text{OE}}$ HIGH), A data may be stored in the A register.









FIGURE 5. Standard AC Test Load




FIGURE 8. Propagation Delay Waveforms for Inverting and Non-Inverting Functions




FIGURE 9. Propagation Delay, Pulse Width Waveforms







FIGURE 10. 3-STATE Output HIGH and LOW Enable and Disable Times
