



This 12 V, 9.9 m $\Omega$ , 2.2 mm × 1.15 mm LGA Dual NexFET™ power MOSFET is designed to minimize resistance and gate charge in a small footprint. Its small footprint and common drain configuration make the device ideal for battery pack applications in small handheld devices.









Figure 5. Capacitance









Figure 7. On-State Source-to-Source Resistance vs Gate-to-Source Voltage

Figure 8. Normalized On-State Resistance vs Temperature






Figure 10. Maximum Source Current vs Temperature









