

#### description

The SN74CBTS6800 provides ten bits of high-speed TTL-compatible bus switching with Schottky diodes on the I/Os to clamp undershoots.

The low on-state resistance of the switch allows bidirectional connections to be made, while adding near-zero propagation delay. The device also precharges the B port to a user-selectable bias voltage (BIASV) to minimize live-insertion noise.

# DB, DBQ, DGV, DW, OR PW PACKAGE (TOP VIEW)



The SN74CBTS6800 is organized as one 10-bit switch with a single enable  $(\overline{ON})$  input. When  $\overline{ON}$  is low, the switch is on, and port A is connected to port B. When  $\overline{ON}$  is high, the switch between port A and port B is open. When  $\overline{ON}$  is high or  $V_{CC}$  is 0 V, B port is precharged to BIASV through the equivalent of a 10-k $\Omega$  resistor.




